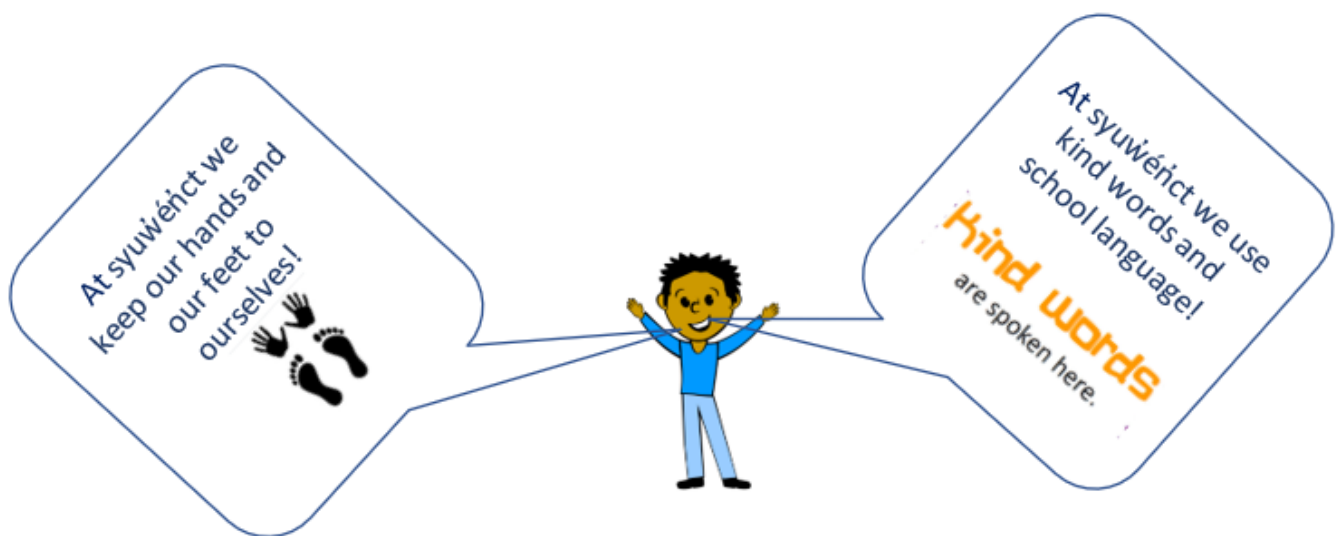
WANT A DIFFERENT WAY TO SHOW SUPPORT FOR SHAI?
